Membership in Audubon of Southwest Florida, Inc., headquartered in Ft. Myers, Florida, is open to any person interested in the conservation, educational, and scientific pursuits of Audubon of Southwest Florida. New chapter memberships include a one year membership in the National Audubon Society and Audubon of Florida. A current National Audubon promotion results in all new national membership payments being returned to the chapter as long as the chapter code, C9ZE330Z , is noted on the application to indicate your desire to affiliate with Audubon of Southwest Florida.

For renewing members, we offer a "chapter-only" calendar-year membership to focus your financial support on chapter activities. Initial chapter-only memberships will run to 12/31/10. The chapter currently receives less than \$2.00 of your annual \$35.00 National Audubon renewal fee. You do not have to be a resident of Southwest Florida nor a member of National Audubon to be a chapter member. We suggest that "snowbirds" and tourists maintain their National Audubon membership at their primary address and join us to support local and regional efforts to protect habitat and birding and outdoors opportunities in Southwest Florida and the Everglades.
